- 7. Approx \$7000 will be saved on the meter project because there are several that will not need replacing; COVID 19 contingency plan was discussed, PW will start staggering work hours and working longer on weekends to distance. Gausman will be fixing the streetlight at McKay/S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Joel could help on weekends, Emerson will check on WRS rules; Sanitary sewer lines will be treated by a grouting company to limit processing after a storm. Purchase of a Service agreement for generator at business park needs further information before a decision can be made. Gausman is watching for used street sweepers.
