Chairman Olson called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. at the Village Hall.

Approval of Agenda: Motion (O'Connell/Erickson) to approve agenda moving item 7 up to 3. Carried

- 1. Section 6-13 Animals Resident present concerning chickens being allowed in the village, discussion between committee members, Chief Verges, and resident. A sample ordinance will be written and presented at the next Ordinance Committee meeting and the committee will work with that to see if something is passable. Ordinance would need to be worded as "poultry" or "fowl" to include resident's possession of ducks.
- 2. Section 30-1(37) Vaping Chief will remove "Statement of Purpose", start with definitions to more closely follow our model. Age changes from 21 to 18. Motion (Olson/O'Connell) for full board approval with these revisions.
- 3. Section 22-65 Revocation of liquor license/22-301 Street Use Permits review Motion (Olson/Erickson) point system Section 22-65/22-92 should be enforced. Section 22-301 through 308 "Street Use Permit" will be enforced. Discussion centered on recent requests from, and granted to, bar owners but their lack of regard for safety and authority. No updates needed to Revocation ordinance. Street Use Permit ordinance will have fees and down payment included on the fee schedule to be \$50 non-refundable application fee, \$1000 deposit which will be refundable at the discretion of the Village when satisfactory after-event clean up has been done, no damage to Village property has been identified, no other cause for retaining. Emerson will provide Street Use Permit for approval.
- **4. Section 2-143 Board of Review: Motion (O'Connell/Erickson)** to update 2-143(b)(2) adjusting compensation to \$35.00. and 2-143(c) to change meeting time to be set mutually between Village and Assessor and within state guidelines. Carried.
- 5. Section 58-231 Commercial zoned setbacks: Motion (Olson/Erickson) to set front side and rear setbacks to zero in order to comply with existing and standard downtown commercial setbacks. Carried.
- 6. Section 18-7 Lawn and Grass Length Regulated tabled for future modification
- 7. Section 58-171 R-2 lot coverage maximum tabled for future modification
- **8.** Ordinance 2-142 Residency Required for Service: Motion (Olson/Erickson) to add exception that Village Clerk will serve on Board of Review.
