NOTICE OF CHECK DISHONOR

The purpose of this NOTICE is to give you the statutory five-day notice in accordance with the Worthless Check Statute 943.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes. If within 5 days after receiving this notice of non-payment, you fail to pay the below described check or checks, you will have committed a crime against the state of Wisconsin. In addition, you are liable for the cost of the mailing of this Notice and a \$00.00 service charge per check. The check or checks are as follows:
