Approval of Agenda: Motion (O'Connell/Huepfel) to approve agenda. Carried

- Burn permit requirements: Refuse pile is being looked at to move to just north of Losert property. We will send approval letters to the six property owners that would be affected by a burn permit. At that time we will meet again to plan a move and see if all those affected approved.
- 2. Previous employee has been approved by PW to return for snow plowing.
- 3. We are still within our extension period for treatment plant permitting. We still need one Water Quality Trade Agreement from SV Telephone before we can move forward.
- 4. Adams had an overhead presentation of the proposed All-Purpose Trail showing 10' lanes, 10' trail, and shoulder. Laterals along both sides of Van Buren were reviewed as well as culverts. A lot of history to the area was brought up by several residents who attended and knew when certain pieces of the existing road were put in. The trail will be exclusively on the east side of Van Buren. Width of Trail and Van Buren were reviewed, speed limits were discussed, blind spots, crossing at White Tail and Aspen Drive, wetlands, future build on open lot. Height of curb separating trail and road was also discussed, Cedar may look at raising it to help protect and define the area. There will be a public informational meeting later in November or early December in which all Van Buren residents as well as some on Red Fox, Silver Fox, White Tail, and Aspen will have the opportunity to meet and review the plan.
