Chairman Huepfel called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. at the Village Hall.

Approval of Agenda: **Motion (P. Koch/Erickson) to approve agenda. Carried**

- 1. Junk cars/appliances in yards 30-73, 30-75, 50-52, 50-59.** “Unsightly debris” is currently in 30-75. Add to ordinance 30-75 “Anyone notified of non-compliance of this ordinance will have 20 days to comply with the order issued to correct the conditions. If premises remains non-compliant a citation will be issued, each week of non-compliance constitutes a new offense. An appeal can be made to Emergency Services Committee.” Emerson will check fee schedule to make sure this ordinance is listed.
- 2. ATVs 50-152: Section 50-142(e)** will be amended to read “Time of operation: No ATVs shall be permitted on the route from sunset to sunrise. **50-142(f)** will be amended to read “No person shall operate any all-terrain vehicle within the Village of Spring Valley in excess of posted speed limits. **50-142(g)(7)** will be amended to read “All ATV operators under age 14 must be under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian at all times when operating on a designated all-terrain vehicle route.
- 3. Street Use Permits 22-301 through 309:** Section 22-301(a) shall be added and include the statement “Only one Street Use Permit shall be issued to an establishment or organization per licensing year which runs from July 1st – June 30th. Time of street closure on McKay Avenue from So. 3rd Street to First Street will not begin until after noon on any requested date except for those requests deemed to be Village events, including but not limited to Dam Days Celebration. Any request for downtown street closure before noon will begin 140’ north of the So. 3rd/McKay Ave intersection, which is at the north side of S232 McKay Ave., until noon.

Next meeting will not be scheduled until after Annual Meeting on April 16, 2024.
