The Village Board for the Village of Spring Valley, Pierce and St. Croix County, Wisconsin does hereby amend the Code of Ordinance, Village of Spring Valley, Section numbered 6-6(7)(b)(1), to reads as follows:

Sec 6-6(7)(b)(1)

No vicious dog shall be allowed off the premises of its owner unless such a dog is muzzled and on a leash no longer than 4 feet in length, and under control of the owner or a member of the owner's immediate family over 18 years of age. For purpose of this subsection, a dog shall be deemed as being of a vicious disposition if, the animal is a pit bull dog, or within any 12 month....by the police authorities. Pit bull dog means and includes any of the following dogs: the Staffordshire Bull Terrier breed of dogs, the American Staffordshire Terrier breed of dogs, the American Pit Bull Terrier, any and all dogs that have the appearance and characteristics of being predominantly of the breeds of dogs known as Staffordshire Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier or American Pit Bull Terrier.

No vicious dog shall be allowed to reside in any home, residence, kennel or property that is rented, bartered, given, leased or otherwise not owned by the owner of the vicious dog; furthermore, no vicious dog will be allowed to reside on any property if the vicious dog is not owned by the owner of the property.

When a vicious dog is kept on the property of its owner the vicious dog shall not be kept in any type of outdoor kennel, under the control of any type of wireless fencing and the owner or a member of the owner's immediate family 18 years of age or older shall be with the vicious dog anytime it is outside of the primary structure on the property.
