
MAY 5-9 HYDRANT FLUSHING Public Works will be flushing fire hydrants during this week. This is a requirement of the Public Service Commission. After flushing in your neighborhood, if your water appears cloudy or dark, let it run until clear. Remember to check your water before washing clothes to prevent staining. Residents with water softeners should also check cycle times of their units so the softener does not regenerate during this time period.

PET REGISTRATIONS ARE NOW PAST DUE

Cost until April 1st: \$20.00—Spayed/Neutered Dog/Cat \$30.00-Intact Dog/Cat \$5 late fee Registrations were due April 1st. For each unregistered pet there will be a \$5.00 late fee added onto your registration. If **NOT** registered by end of day on April 18th a Police Citation (\$181.60) will be issued. Citations are scheduled to be sent on April 21st, please register before then!
