Emergency Services Committee minutes
October 24 2019**

Call to Order: Jacobson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Village Hall.

Approval of Agenda: Motion (Jacobson/Vorlicek) to approve the agenda. Carried

1. Verges reported the noise problem at north end football field is due to the radio music being played out the loudspeakers pregame and halftime. Robelia said he can't hear his own radio in his garage with the door shut. He believes it is the angle of the speakers that the game people don't here the same loud noise he does. Verges is working with the school to keep the noise at an acceptable level.
2. ES will recommend to full board the purchase of a squad from the Pierce County Sheriff's inventory available for purchase. There is enough in CI for another vehicle. The 2007 will not be repaired any further. Jacobson has discussed sale of '07 and believes the Village can get good portion back from what has been put into it recently. Most equipment would transfer, cage would be needed.
3. Phase I and II of the computer maintenance to bring system compliance will be done by year end. Phase III will wait until 2021 to see where the state program is at.
4. 2020 budget looks good. Lexipol annual contract was added, our current police ordinance system is outdated and no good without current updates.
5. Applicants are coming in; they will all be reviewed next week. Verges will look into cameras for all Village buildings.
