- Henning will be deployed in August for a year, Dulcie Lilly will be starting PT 3/25/2020 3-4 days/month. Possibly check with retired officers/county deputies to fill in PT. Verges will hire PT employees within her budget
- 2<sup>nd</sup> squad went down, radiator needs replacing. PW had it repaired, costs to be split between PW and ES. New batch of squads will be available in August, put on May agenda. Computer in main squad needs replacing, options would be rugged and semi-rugged models.
- Stand alone radar is being considered for squads, they are more accurate than a squad wired/mounted. o/s is getting old, needs updating. Chief to come up with a priority list of equipment needs. 35mm camera is also needed. Chief will work on a body cam ordinance.
- General updates: many dog issues in the village. Dogs problems have been numerous on Golfview and in the Church St/Burro Lane neighborhood. Licensing letters will be going out beginning of April then tickets will be issued. Letters will be going out to all pet owners about leash ordinance, picking up after dogs, being able to read meters, etc. Second street speeding is still an issue. We don't currently have staff to patrol as often as requested and the county speed trailer is not available to municipalities. Until we come up with another solution personal responsibility is advised. COVID 19 precautions are being taken between PD and EMTs as well as police department in-house.
