Agenda items

1. Squad update: Ford has admitted they are not making 2022 vehicles so we have no new squad in queue. Ewald Ford had a 2023 Police Interceptor come off the delivery truck and they pulled it aside for Village of Spring Valley, knowing we have been trying to get a new squad for 2 years. Cost is \$5,100 more than our original budget. 2014 is in and out of repair and length of future service is questionable. Officer Lilly is advised to sign the agreement and move forward. We may be able to get more than expected at auction on the 2014 looking at what used police vehicles are going for.
2. Office Lilly did a firearms audit; she will check with DOJ to see if we can sell them. Her suggestion was to donate to local trap club.
3. Chauncey Helgeson is the new IT support; he has reviewed our current status and will be working further with Officer Lilly.
4. General updates: \$7000 grant was received; wellness program is coming along; SV Auto Repair will be given time to move cars from alley or they will be towed; FT Chief may be in the 2024 budget.
